EXTENSION CORD INSPECTION GUIDELINES

Forward Laser & extension cord checklists to Elaine in Payroll with the first timesheet submitted in Jan, April, July & Oct

Extension cords should be inspected prior to each use.

If extension cords become damaged during use cut the male end of extension cord off.

Extension cords are to be inspected and color coded quarterly:

- > January thru March White
- > April thru June Green
- ➤ July thru September **Red**
- October thru December Orange

What to look for:

- Cracks or damage to insulation or plugs/prongs on both ends
- > Exposed wires, burn marks
- Broken, bent or missing prongs (ground prong)
- Continuity tested
